Directions:

Each student will submit an assignment based on a physical or mental disorder approved by the health teacher. The topic chosen should have meaning to the student. (Think about- family history, friends, future occupation). The assignment entails answering four questions about the disorder chosen; the necessary information will be gathered by using the library data bases.

1. Cover page: 5 points BE CREATIVE (1 PAGE)

Top left

Topic or title centered

- any font
- color

2. Format: 40 points The body of the assignment will include four sections detailing the following: Please number and label each section within your assignment.

1. Description of the topic (should be several paragraphs) -10 points

2. Symptoms (length, at least ½ page) -10 points

3. Treatment (length, at least ½ page)-10 points

4. Why I chose this topic (length will differ) - 10 points

The questions answered should total 2-4 pages in length (most are 3)

Suggestions for information you could use to research and write each section

1. Describe topic (suggestions: history, statistics, causes, demographics)
2. Symptoms (suggestions: how does it affect the body, mind, a person's lifestyle)
3. What is the treatment? (Suggestions: cure, care, and prevention)
4. Why did the student choose the topic? (suggestion: reflect upon what you learned, how are you going to use this information, did it change your feelings, way of thinking, and or understanding)
